1. **Open and Welcome:** Joanna Wilkins

2. **Agenda Items:**

- Review data-based options for student-driven academic plans.
 - iReady: Diagnostic test with Math and English teachers.
 - Tier 1 is “grade level,” Tier 3 is “at risk.” This diagnostic was taken during the first couple weeks of school.
 - Math: Tier 1 = 29%, Tier 2 = 40%, Tier 3 = 31%.
 - English: Tier 1 = 35%, Tier 2 = 25%, Tier 3 = 40%.
 - Parents need iReady access to view their students’ data. Students should have their own access and could show their parents/guardians.
- Trustlands starting amount \$110,000
 - Hire a .7 teacher to reduce class sizes in English \$45,000
 - Teacher training and conferences \$15,000
 - \$16,000 carry over for technology - new chromebooks
 - Technician for core classes \$10,000
 - Left over \$24,000
 - Options? “Lab Bus” - this could facilitate students who would like to stay after and work in a lab/study hall. If students ride the bus they usually can’t take advantage of the lab resource.
 - Would like to continue again with SPED technician and other technician if helpful
 - We’ll re-evaluate in January when we can see the next diagnostic data
 - Sora (MyOn) is a \$5,000 reading program that will need to be paid for out of Trustlands next year
 - May need funding for additional teachers to cover elective class load (FTE)
- Reading in 6th grade is currently a semester course; next calendar year 2021-22 it may move to a year-long course.

- Parents would like Infinite Campus emails to have more clarification. It doesn't state the school, student, or other information. If teachers could help a bit by adding the course title/grade/school (this could be in the teacher's tagline), that would help parents to know which student it is referring to.
