

Please be aware that your student will not receive their yearbook (if one was purchased) on early distribution day if you have unpaid fees. It will be held until the last day of school. #### UTAH IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 7TH GRADE ENTRY 2023/2024

#### **Utah Immunization Requirements for**

7th Grade Entry 2023/2024

To attend the 7th grade in Utah a student must have proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- 1 Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap) booster \*\*\*MUST CONTAIN PERTUSSIS\*\*\*
- o Tdap required regardless of interval since last dose tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine
- o Kindergarten dose does not count as booster requirement for 7th grade
- o Td is not acceptable
- 1 Meningococcal Vaccine

To claim a personal, religious, or medical exemption, the legal guardian must complete an online educational module (free of charge) and provide a copy of the certificate to the school. The online module can be found at <a href="https://apps.usiis.org/vac\_edu\_module/">https://apps.usiis.org/vac\_edu\_module/</a>.

If you do not have access to a computer, the online educational module may be completed at the Utah County Health Department or at your student's school.

For a medical exemption, a written notice from a licensed health care provider must be provided. The notice should state the physical condition of the student, and why that vaccine would endanger the student's life or health. Additionally, a copy of the online exemption certificate needs to be provided.

If you have a financial need for low cost or free vaccines, please contact your school nurse.

You can return this information to your	student's current school, or to the middle/junior high
