Bus expectations parent email:

We are getting ready for the coming school year and are excited to have our fantastic VVMS students back. Many of our new students will be riding the bus to school for the first time. Our transportation department is amazing and keeps our students safe and our students are part of that plan. We hope you will prepare your first-time bus riders for the expectations on our Nebo buses. Please go over the following expectations with your bus riders.

Students should know that their behavior on the bus affects the safety of all students and is just like their classroom behavior. Students should listen to bus drivers and follow all instructions given. Riding the bus is a privilege and students who break school rules on the buses can lose that privilege.

Students can help with bus safety in the following ways:

**B**e responsible:

- Take care of yourself and others
- Keep the bus clean
- Own your behavior on the bus

**U**se respect:

- Stop, listen and respond politely to driver and aides
- Use kind words and actions
- Don't distract the bus driver

**S**tay safe:

- Keep hands and head inside the bus
- Sit on seat and stay in seat
- Hands and feet to self
- Use an "inside" voice to keep the noise level down

## Instructions for Dropping students off and Picking them up at VVMS



Within Drop-off area please follow these rules.

1. For safety, keep speeds low.
2. Students should enter the car using designated Cross walk and side walks to get to the cars. Instruct them not to dash between cars to get to your vehicle.
3. Use left and right lanes for dropping-off or picking-up students.
4. The center lane is for exiting the Drop-off/Pick-up area.
5. Do not allow students to exit or enter car when you are in the center lane.
6. Please follow the directions of our representative as they direct traffic.
7. **Do not use teacher parking or bus area for drop-off or pick-up.**

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## What Lunch do I go to?

1st and second lunch is determined by each students 4th period teacher. Teachers are listed below with their assigned lunch. If I were a student and had Mr. Haskell for my 4th period class, I would go from 3rd period straight to lunch. After lunch I would go to 4th period then continue though the day.
