



Sit on seat and stay in seat


Hands and feet to self

Instructions for Dropping students off and Picking them up at VVMS

Within Drop-off area please follow these rules.

- 1. For safety, keep speeds low.
- 2. Students should enter the car using designated Cross walk and side walks to get to the cars. Instruct them not to dash between cars to get to your vehicle.
- 3. Use left and right lanes for dropping-off or picking-up students.
- 4. The center lane is for exiting the Drop-off/Pick-up area.
- 5. Do not allow students to exit or enter car when you are in the center lane.
- 6. Please follow the directions of our representative as they direct traffic.
- 7. Do not use teacher parking or bus area for drop-off or pick-up.

What Lunch do I go to?

Lockers


